



Creating your PACTivist Page – *read below for instructions on accessing your already existing page*

PACTivist Pages are personal fundraising pages created by you to raise money for the NEA Fund. Each dollar you raise on your page will be credited toward your goal toward the Representative Assembly. Supporting the NEA Fund and spreading the word by sharing your page with others is vital to supporting public education and electing state and federal candidates who share our values. Here's how you get started!

Step 1 – Click Here

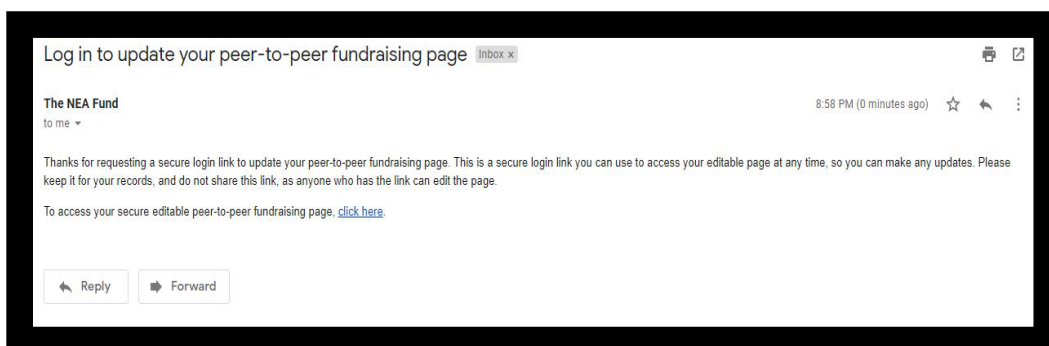

Step 2 – Complete Form

Complete the form and don't forget to check the acknowledgment.

Step 3 – Check your email

You will receive the following email. Please read it carefully. This email contains a link. This link is for you to ACCESS your page and EDIT it. When you've created a personal PACTivist Page, there is no need to login to edit or check on your page. Again, you will use the link provided in the email you receive after completing the form. See the image below for a sample of the email.



Step 4 – Click the link in the email

Click the link in the email you received after signing up. This link will take you to the following web page.

At the top of the page is your personal PACTivist Fundraising page link. This is the link you will share when you ask for contributions. When someone clicks on this link, they will be taken to your PACTivist Page to make a contribution.

The next section is to update your fundraising goal.

In the “About” section you can edit and put anything you’d like here. The best thing to say is why you support the PAC and why it’s important to you!

Step 5 – Raise Money!

That’s it, you’ve done it and now you can raise money! Email your colleagues and family members and ask them to join you in supporting public education champions running for office. Here are a few reminders:

Money given on a PACTivist Page is credited to the owner of the page for internal NEA fundraising activities only. All contributions are filed with the Federal Elections Commission as donated by the contributor.

Only NEA members and their household family members can give to the NEA Fund.

Accessing Your PACTivist Page

To access your PACTivist Page if you're unable to find the original email or link, you can follow the steps below to access your page again.

Step 1 – Click Here – www.edvotes.org/fundraise

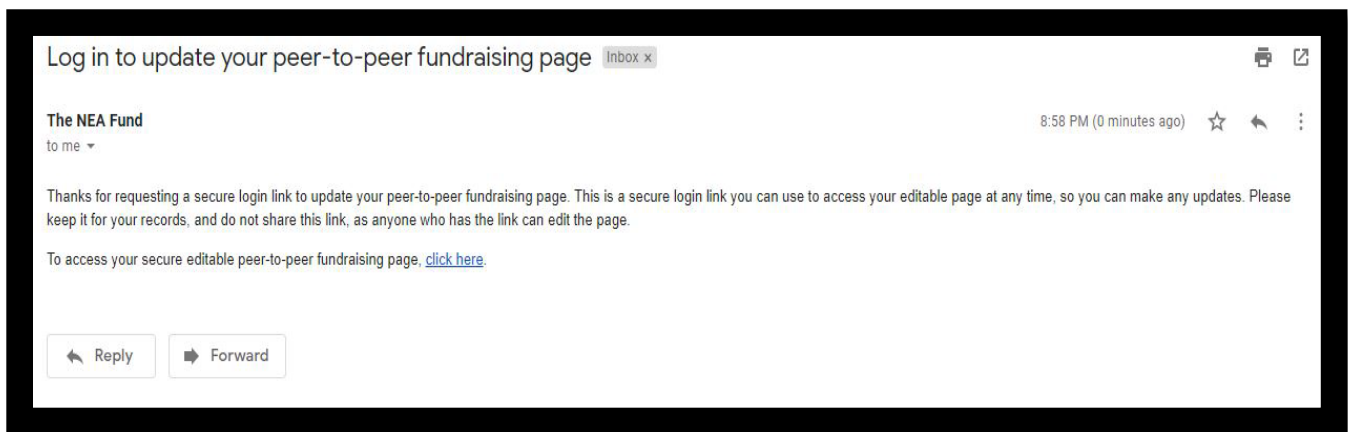
YES! It's the same page where you would sign up.

Step 2 – Complete Form

Complete the form, make sure you use the same email you used to sign up.

Step 3 – Check your email

You will receive the following email with your personalized fundraising link again. You can save that link somewhere to access it any time!



Please note PACTivist Pages will NOT “reset” this year to maintain data integrity. If you would like to update your goal, please do so by accessing your page using the steps above!

Contributions to the NEA Fund are not deductible as charitable contributions. Contributions to the NEA Fund are voluntary and will be used for political purposes. Making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in NEA, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without reprisal. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount, or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting membership status, rights or benefits in NEA or any of its affiliates. Federal law requires NEA to use its best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year.
