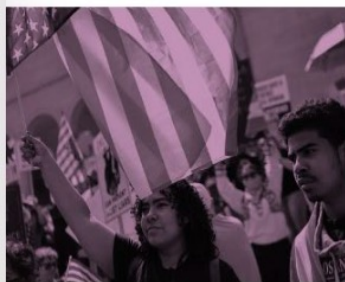


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Day of Learning*

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- Sessions will span two and a half days. Starts the afternoon of Day 3 and the morning of Day 4
- A total of 30 (vs 5 in 2025) sessions across the full duration of the RA
- Four session blocks
 - shorter sessions (90 minutes vs. 120 minutes)
 - smaller session sizes (average. 250 vs. 1200)
- Differentiated levels (1 - foundational, 2 - mobilizing & power building, 3 - agenda driving)
- Aligned with NEA Leadership Competencies Framework
- Delegates will be able to register for sessions when they register for the RA
- RA Ambassadors will be available for assistance (ie. Directions, etc.)
